**Title:** Clinical Partner- Part-time (17.5 hours/ week)

### **Job Description:**

The Clinical Partner will work closely with the Program Director in order to offer clinical consultations and support to FRC staff. The Clinical Partner will serve as a liaison between the FRC and mental health providers in the community. The Clinical Partner will co-facilitate educational workshops on selected topics.

### **Job Duties and Responsibilities Include:**

- The Clinical Partner will work closely with Program Director to offer clinical support to FRC Family and Youth Advocates.
- The Clinical Partner will serve as a liaison between FRC and mental health providers within the FRC zone.
- The Clinical Partner is responsible for co-facilitating clinical workshops (internal and external workshops) on selected topics.
- The Clinical Partner will assist FRC staff in identifying mental health and other supportive services available to families and youth.
- The Clinical Partner will review case records and provide feedback to staff around documentation, including record analysis, case reviews, and rounds.
- The Clinical Partner will provide seminars for FRC staff on various topics to enhance their knowledge around interventions, medications, diagnosis and other relevant topics.

### **Qualifications:**

The Clinical Partner will be a licensed social worker, psychologist, or mental health clinician with experience working with families and with children with emotional and/ or behavioral needs. Experience facilitating groups and offering educational workshops preferred. Bilingual and bicultural candidates are encouraged to apply.
