TITLE OF POSITION: OUTREACH WORKER - Full Time

About the Program

The Circle of Security Parent Coaching Department helps parents and caregivers understand what their child needs from them. Through a series of group-based sessions, parents and caregivers learn how to read their child's emotional needs, support their child's ability to manage emotions, enhance their child's self-esteem, and honor their child's desire to be secure.

About the Position

The Outreach Worker position is a full-time position. The Outreach Worker conducts telephone, written and face to face outreach and engagement activities to facilitate collaborations with community based organizations. Outreach staff work closely with the COS Parent Coaching team to identify, engage and recruit both caregivers and providers to create and maintain ongoing parenting classes in targeted areas. The Outreach Worker also supports the program by identifying and sharing information on community resources and services that may benefit the caregivers we serve. This is a field-based position and daily travel is required.

Responsibilities

- Work closely with Senior Outreach Specialist & Program Director to implement strategic outreach plan as set forth as a team
- Develop short-term outreach plan and goals
- Identify faith based-organizations
- Plan and coordinate outreach activities in designated areas that are intended to identify, capture the attention and interest of parents and caregivers that meet the requirements of the program;
