Position Description: Assess, plan and evaluate the mental health and care of adult individuals with mental illness. Responsible for performing the duties of a Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner including - completion of psychiatric assessments and updates, medication management, and psychiatric crisis intervention. The position also requires strong writing and computer skills to ensure compliance with OMH and Medicaid requirements.

Major Job Duties/Responsibilities:

- Perform and document initial psychiatric evaluation of all individuals admitted to the clinic component of the program
- Perform and document psychiatric updates as needed and required
- Review and assess Individualized Recovery Plans
- Facilitate medication management and symptom management support groups
- Maintain up-to-date charting and other documentation as required
- Provide crisis intervention, including emergency hospital admission support
- Actively participate in team meetings and weekly Clinical meetings
- Complete trainings in Evidence Based Practices for working with dually disordered individuals and tobacco treatment.
- This is a 1.5 days per week position. (about 10.5 hours)
